Tuesday 27 <sup>th</sup> October	Discipleship	What does it mean to be a disciple of Jesus Christ in the 21 <sup>st</sup> Century? What are the distinctive challenges and opportunities of this era for disciples.
Tuesday 3 <sup>rd</sup> November	Primacy in the Episcopate	We examine the historical development of primacy from the Pentarchy to Vatican 1, Orthodoxy and the monarchical papacy, and the position of Constantinople today.
Tuesday 10 <sup>th</sup> November	The Old Testament in the Church	The Old Testament in the New Testament, the Fathers, theology today, in study and in prayer.
Tuesday 17 <sup>th</sup> November	Music in Orthodoxy	The roots of chant in the synagogue, the historical development of chants, the place of hymns in the Church and contemporary developments.
